### **Directions to Baker-Seekamp, 110 Overlook CT., Imperial, MO**

Imperial is located just off of I-55, about 10 miles south of the Intersection of I-55 and I-255/270 on the south end of St. Louis. It is about 25 minutes from downtown St. Louis. Your GPS will guide you here – but we suggest you bring these directions along as the last few turns come quickly.

Travel south on I-55 to Imperial Main Street, exit #186. At the top of the ramp, turn left (east) and proceed over the top of I-55. You are now in the tiny town of Imperial. Proceed approximately 1/2 mile to the 2<sup>nd</sup> stop light at the intersection of US 61/67. On your right will be a lumber company/hardware store. Turn right/south. In less than ½ mile you will turn left at the first stoplight onto Windsor Harbor Road. You will see a school on the corner.

NOW PAY CLOSE ATTENTION – you are within 2 minutes of our house and there are several fast turns! Proceed on Windsor Harbor a short distance – it will make a 90 degree right turn, then an immediate 90 degree left turn, then an immediate 90 degree right turn. As soon as you make the last right turn, look straight ahead and you will see a road that goes straight and up a wooded hill – take that road (Waters Road - the sign is obscured by tree branches). Proceed on Waters road about ½ mile, past a large water storage tank, and shortly you will see a gated subdivision on the left – Shipwatch. If the gate is closed, Follow the instructions on the gate phone (you can use it from your car window) and we will buzz you in. Proceed on Shipwatch drive to the first and only left, Overlook Court. We are the only residence on Overlook – proceed past the guest house to the main house. As a point of reference on your map or GPS, our home is located directly on the Mississippi River.
